All selected Tram Shelters are located in the midst of Central Business Districts, shopping and entertainment communities. Tramways and Cody aim to benefit tram passengers, pedestrians and retail communities in the near vicinity. Pursuant to its "Catch a ride, Catch a smile" slogan, Tramways is keen to offer convenient online experience to all customers.

This 6-month pilot run will be featured at 8 Tram Shelter locations:

- Pennington Street in Causeway Bay (Tram Shelter #46W)
- Paterson Street in Causeway Bay (Tram Shelter #48W)
- Percival Street in Causeway Bay (Tram Shelter #51E)
- Foo Ming Street in Causeway Bay (Tram Shelter #105)
- O'Brien Road in Wan Chai (Tram Shelter #43E)
- Pedder Street in Central (Tram Shelter #27E)
- Gilman Street in Sheung Wan (Tram Shelter #74W)
- Man Wah Lane in Sheung Wan (Tram Shelter #76W)

To try out this new pilot service, users just need to search out "**H**ERE**W**IFI**F**REE" on their mobile device and open the browser to connect. Starting from now till 16 May 2018, users would have a chance to win a "TramOramic Tour" ticket (20 prizes) by sharing a reason why you love riding a tram on Tramways' Facebook page.
